General Information:

- Scholarship amount is up to \$1,000 and must be used for tuition and fees
- Scholarship is not renewable
- Recipients will be notified prior to graduation

Eligibility/Requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of Yamhill-Carlton High School
- Applicant must be attending a University, College or Trade School in the fall
- Scholarships will be awarded in each of the three following categories:
 - **Academics, The Arts, Vocational Careers**
- Applicants will select one of the three areas of focus, and must provide evidence of excellence in their chosen area. Examples of excellence could include but are not limited to:
 - Academic achievement as demonstrated in school transcripts
 - Participation in school sponsored events
 - Artistic portfolio
 - Vocational resume and list of qualifications/projects/jobs completed
 - Volunteer experience in community events and/or community service
 - 2 letters of recommendation from community members, teachers and others as the applicant may deem beneficial, at least one which speaks directly to the chosen area of focus.
 - Written narrative sharing your history, personal/educational accomplishments, future educational/career goals (how a college degree or higher education certificate will help you achieve them) and financial need.

Payment:

- The awarded applicant will be required to provide the Foundation with his/her Verification of Enrollment from the college, university or trade school where he/she has been accepted.
- Upon verification of the student's registration as a full-time student, payment will be made directly to the educational institution. It will not be made to the student. The funds must be applied toward payment of tuition costs and fees for the school year immediately following the date the award is announced. Awards offered, but not verified by December 31st of the year during which the award was granted will be withdrawn.
- In the event the student terminates his/her studies for any reason, the un-disbursed balance of the scholarship must be returned to the Yamhill-Carlton Education Foundation. There is no provision for the monies to be transferred to another school and may not be paid to the student.
